

How to submit an abstract

Please follow the guidelines on this page before submitting your abstract. The abstract submission deadline is **April 6th, 2025 23:59:00 ART (UTC-3)**.

1. The abstract body should be short (up to 250 words), clear, concise, and written in English with correct spelling and good sentence structure.
 - 1.a. Use a text editor of your choice to compile your abstract: title, author(s), affiliation(s) of author(s), and abstract text. References can be included. **Templates in MS Word, LibreOffice and Latex** are provided.
 - 1.b. Mathematical symbols and equations can be typed in.
 - 1.c. You can browse the session list and select the one you are interested in

 - 1.d. Consider that submitting the same abstract to more than one session is not allowed. Duplicates will be rejected.
 - 1.e. Select your preference for oral presentation or poster presentation.
 - 1.f. Abstracts should be carefully compiled and thoroughly checked, particularly the list of authors, before submission to avoid last-minute changes.
2. Register at: <https://backend.congresos.unlp.edu.ar/index.php/ADRESES/>. Log in and submit your abstracts.
 - 2.a. You must upload 2 files for each abstract: the *.doc, *.odt, or *.tex file and the produced *.pdf file. Uploading the abstracts files is mandatory.
 - 2.b. A confirmation message including your abstract number will be displayed and you will receive a confirmation email providing your abstract number. If you did not receive the abstract submission confirmation email, please check your spam folder first before contacting us at iaus401 at fcaglp.unlp.edu.ar.
3. The submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the SOC and accepted or rejected. The accepted contributions must be presented onsite or virtually by the author or co-author during the meeting. If this is not possible, please withdraw your abstract as soon as possible, by email to iaus401 at fcaglp.unlp.edu.ar.
4. By submitting an abstract, authors consent to its publication in the open-access IAU Symposium 401 Abstracts Book, that will be available at the La Plata University Repository (<https://sedici.unlp.edu.ar/>).
