How to submit an abstract

Please follow the guidelines on this page before submitting your abstract. The abstract submission deadline is **April 6th, 2025 23:59:00 ART (UTC-3)**.

- 1. The abstract body should be short (up to 250 words), clear, concise, and written in English with correct spelling and good sentence structure.
 - 1.a.Use a text editor of your choice to compile your abstract: title, author(s), affiliation(s) of author(s), and abstract text. References can be included.
 Templates in MS Word, LibreOffice and Latex are provided.
 - 1.b.Mathematical symbols and equations can be typed in.
 - 1.c. You can browse the session list and select the one you are interested in
 - 1) Earth rotation models and Earth Orientation Parameters (EOP)
 - 2) Celestial and terrestrial reference systems/frames
 - Reference systems/frames for the Moon and other solar system bodies
 - 4) Time scales and time metrology
 - 5) Ephemerides of solar system objects
 - 6) Astronomical standards
 - 1.d.Consider that submitting the same abstract to more than one session is not allowed. Duplicates will be rejected.
 - 1.e. Select your preference for oral presentation or poster presentation.
 - 1.f.Abstracts should be carefully compiled and thoroughly checked, particularly the list of authors, before submission to avoid last-minute changes.

 - 2.a. You must upload 2 files for each abstract: the *.doc, *.odt, or *.tex file and the produced *.pdf file. Uploading the abstracts files is mandatory.
 - 2.b.A confirmation message including your abstract number will be displayed and you will receive a confirmation email providing your abstract number. If you did not receive the abstract submission confirmation email, please check your spam folder first before contacting us at iaus401 at fcaglp.unlp.edu.ar.
- 3. The submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the SOC and accepted or rejected. The accepted contributions <u>must be presented onsite or virtually by the author or coauthor during the meeting.</u> If this is not possible, please withdraw your abstract as soon as possible, by email to iaus401 at fcaglp.unlp.edu.ar.
- 4. By submitting an abstract, authors consent to its publication in the open-access IAU Symposium 401 Abstracts Book, that will be available at the La Plata University Repository (https://sedici.unlp.edu.ar/).
